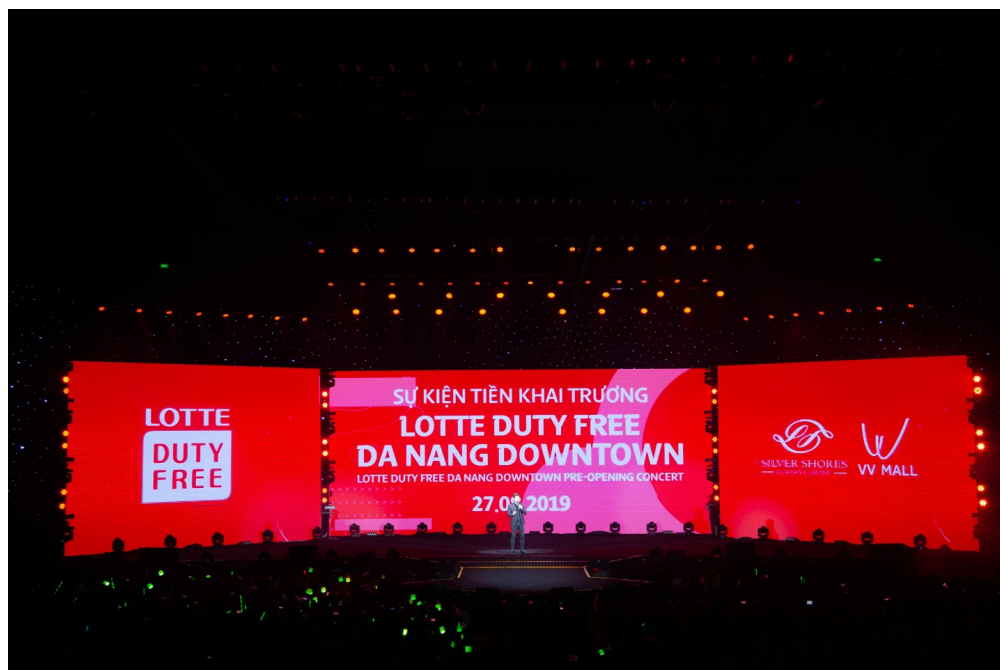


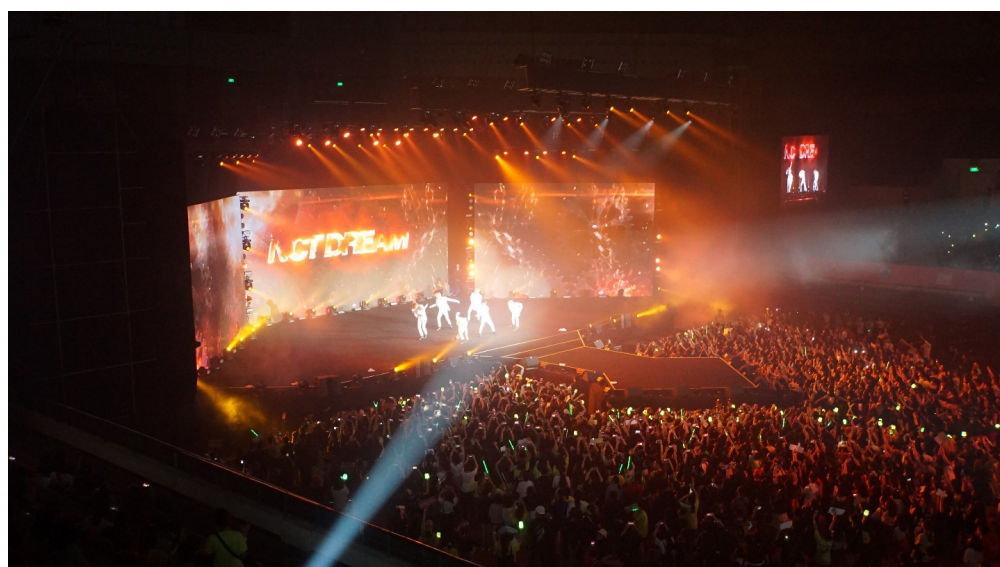
Lotte Duty Free's Da Nang downtown store pre-opening concert draws 4,000 people
