

# Sara Ali wins 27th Dubai Duty Free UAE Nationals Cup

The format for the day was a gross and individual Stableford, with prizes being awarded to the Overall Stableford Winner, Gross Winner, Ladies Winner, Junior Winner and On-Course Special Event.

Runners-up in the individual stableford was Sohail Al Marzooqi with 31 points as the first runner up, followed by Hassan Al Musharreh with 31 points in second place. The ladies winner was Rabab Al Haj with 29 points.
